

Diamonds and Roses Shawl

- Warp/Weft yarns: 2/14
- Alpaca Silk in Eggplant and Lilac
- Weave structure: Deflected Doubleweave
- Sett: 15 epi
- Number of shafts: 8-shafts



Merriel Miller

One cone lap blanket

- Warp/Weft yarns: 2/8 Jaggerspun Heather in Faded Rose
- Weave structure: Deflected
 Doubleweave
- Sett: 14 epi
- Number of shafts: 8-shafts



Georgean Curran

Wall Hanging

- Approximately 3x5 feet
- Harrisville Highland using two strands together for both warp and weft
- Weave structure: It is a twill I saw somewhere that I tweeked to get rid of overly long floats.
- Sett: 6 epi

Pendleton Selvedge Rug

- Marled rug warp: 1600 yds/lb
- Sett: 5 epi
- Each selvedge shot laid in with the same side oriented up.
- This rug will felt in the wash.

- Harrisville Shetland Yarn
- Sett: 5 EPI
